35 Arrangement entitled "Offering to Offler" Using only a cabbage, a set of dentures and garden wire.

Note to All Exhibitors: Entries in Classes 19, 20, 25 and 33 should be displayed in strong glass bottles or jars with flanged stoppers

and a pressure release valve in the lid. Any loss or damage

resulting from not adhering to these rules will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.

Entries in Class 26, 28 and 29 must be on a waterproof plate with doily and covered in Cling Film.
